The Baltic Sea's beautiful health resort lies on the Flensburg Fjord, the 37 km long arm of the Baltic Sea which connects the most northerly part of Schleswig-Holstein's Baltic coast with Denmark. The picturesque inner fjords of Flensburg offer delightful sandy beaches sheltered from the wind with spectacular views across to the Danish coast on the other side. Whether you're a landlubber or a water rat, a lover of sports or culture, a family or the perfect couple, well, Glücksburg lives up to its name. The „Glücks-Burg“ or Castle of Happiness is a white castle on the sea and is considered to be the „cradle of European royal houses“. The castle, its chapel, the park with own orangery and rose gardens are open to the public all year round. Enjoy the elegant atmosphere of the small town with German hospitality and Scandinavian lifestyle.

# Maritime Atmosphere & Scandinavian Flair

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### THE CASTLE SET ON A LAKE

The famous landmark of the Baltic Sea's health resort is Glücksburg's water castle. Crowned heads from across the whole of Europe once resided here; today visitors are enthralled by the cultural and historical treasures set in their impressive backdrop.

### ROSE GARDENS

In 1990/91, the Glücksburg rose gardens were set out in the former castle gardens covering an area of around one hectare. Visitors can delight in more than 550 varieties of English, historical, modern wild and rambler roses in the gardens styled in the English fashion. Amongst them is the largest collection of English roses in Germany.



### DISCOVER GLÜCKSBURG ON FOOT

A very special way of getting to know Glücksburg is on our guided city tours and historical walks.

### BEACHES

You can experience fun in the sand and romantic sunsets with views across the Danish coast on the coast-guard patrolled beaches in Holnis and Sandwig directly in Glücksburg. The beaches shoreline slopes gently and so is particularly suitable for children. Water rats can splash about, go on pedal boots or clamber around the playgrounds whilst the grown-ups pass the time comfortably sitting in a wicker beach chair.

### HOLNIS PENINSULA

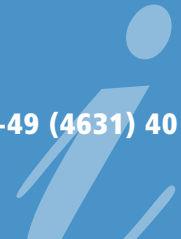
The Holnis peninsula is at the most northerly point of the Angeln countryside and is as close as 1,700 m from the Danish peninsula Broagerland. Here, you can find a large nature reserve with a steep coastline and a well-signposted hiking trail to help you discover the area. The wildly beautiful natural beaches are perfect for swimming and relaxation.

### FERRY CROSSINGS

Why not see both the German and Danish coastlines at the same time from the water for a change, sail around the Ochseninseln or disembark in Denmark. The M/S Viking crosses from Glücksburg to Flensburg and back several times a day from March until December.

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### artefact POWERPARK

„Grasp energy“ is the Power Park's motto, and that is meant in its figurative sense! Or do you know how the sun gets into the socket? The Energy Experience Park has 30 interactive stations covering all aspects of energy production and alternative energies.

### WELLNESS

The wellness section of the Vital Hotel Alter Meierhof and the beach hotel are also available for non-guests (please book in advance). Breathe in deeply in the Salt Temple or let yourself be pampered in the Ayurveda Spa Upanischad, you will find a wealth of healthcare activities in the medimaris health centre.

### FÖRDELAND THERMAL ADVENTURE POOL

Whether you are alone, or a couple, with friends or family – simply enjoy the water, warmth and wellness with all your senses. The large world of bathing with indoor thermal pool, children's area, giant slide and heated outdoor pool invites you to join in on an outstanding water experience.



### MENKE PLANETARIUM

The Menke Planetarium with its numerous events concerning the night sky is a fascinating experience for all kinds of star catchers. Public lectures take place every Tuesday, special events for children on every second Tuesday.
